

DECALOGUE OF THE PROWINTER TEST DAYS & PROVE LIBERE RETAIL BY POOL SCI ITALIA

BEST PRACTICES FOR A SUCCESSFUL TEST

1. To participate in the test, please register in the **dedicated portal** at the following [LINK](#). Our team will support you during the registration phase.
2. Bear in mind that the **registration is nominative** and that you will sign personal documents (privacy and release form) when registering. Therefore, **if you change the name**, we advise you to do this in advance and not at the accreditation desk on the morning of the event, since the procedure would slow down your access to the test.
3. There are many ways to **visit both the Test Days and the trade fair** - you can go to the test on the first day and visit the fair in the afternoon or on the second day. If you are not sure what you want to test and would prefer to find out about the products at the fair first, you can visit the trade fair on the first day and register for the test on the second day. Or: you can register for both days!
4. To help you plan your participation, **take a look at the exhibitors** in the Test Village. That way you can organise your time well and won't miss a single product.
5. Have you already thought about **who to bring with to the Test Days**? Each retail point is entitled to bring two testers. There are lots of products to test, not only for alpine skiing, but also for ski touring and off-piste skiing.

6. A 5-star service: At the end of the day, you will receive a **message summarising all the products** you have tested to help you keep track of your day in the snow. Please remind the exhibitors to link your wristband to all tested products!
7. **Reaching the test is easy:** the parking is located in Carezza, at the valley station of the Paolina/Hubertus ski lifts. For those coming from Val di Fassa, about 1 km after the pass on the left, for those coming from Bolzano, before the pass on the right ([LINK MAP](#)). There you will find a large, free parking and the check-in desk where you can register and pick up everything you need for the test.
8. To facilitate the journey to Carezza as much as possible, we have set up **shuttle buses** that connect the fair with the Test Village (one shuttle every hour between 7.45 am and 3 pm), enabling everyone to move independently between the fair and the test area. 9. **Do you already know where to stay?** If you need tips for accommodation near the test, visit the Carezza website ([LINK](#)). If you prefer to stay in the city, discover the hotels that have an agreement with Fiera Bolzano ([LINK](#)).
10. Remember to **bring your own skis and/or boots**, depending on what you want to test in the Test Village: If you want to test skis, having your own boots on your feet is recommended (as boots are only tested in the ski touring segment). If, on the other hand, you want to test ski touring boots, we recommend taking the skis you normally use.
